

CURRICULUM & TEXTBOOKS

The school is following CBSE curriculum and most of the text books prescribed for the students are published by the NCERT. However in Grades 1 to 5, textbooks other than those published by NCERT, but conforming to the CBSE syllabus are also prescribed.

MADRASSA

Madrassa classes are included in the regular timetable. Textbook for madrassa will be given from the school. Examination and evaluation will be done along with regular subjects. Qualified and experienced teachers will handle madrassa classes.

WORKING DAYS

The school shall be open for students on all working days (Monday through Friday). The school shall deliver lessons online when classes cannot be conducted at school on regular working days during an academic year. The medium of conducting online classes shall be decided by the school and the same shall be intimated to the parents.

EXAMINATIONS

- There will be Two Periodic Tests and Two Terminal Examinations in an academic year, for students up to class X. Unit Tests will be conducted regularly.
- Parents are requested to ensure that their children prepare well for the Unit Tests, Examinations and Activities.
- In each term two subject enrichment activities are compulsory for all the subjects and note book

- Maintenance also is evaluated.
- After each Periodic Tests, the Report Cards will be sent to the parents. It should be signed and returned to the school promptly within 2 days from the date of issuance.
- After each terminal examination, an open forum (face to face programme) will be arranged for the parents and students. Parents of students who couldn't score a pass mark in the examinations will be required to meet the Principal. NO REQUEST FOR RETEST WILL BE ENTERTAINED.
- The senior secondary students will have unit tests and two terminal examinations. The promotion of a student to class XII will be based on the Annual Examination in Class XI. A student must have an average of 40% marks in each subject to be eligible for promotion to class XII.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- School has special gaming area, which the students can use by following the rules .(Special training for Yoga/Karate/Dance/Music is available in the school. It is compulsory for all students of Grades 3 to 9 to join any one of these activities.)
- Special coaching for selected games for selected students will be provided from the school after school hours.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

WORKING HOURS

The school works from Monday through Friday for the students of Grades 1 to 12. The school timings will be from 9.30 am to 4:00 pm. Holiday declared by the State Government / District authorities may not necessarily be applicable to the school. The school may not declare holiday on account of Hartal imposed by political / social organizations, provided vehicles can safely ply on roads.

ATTENDANCE

- All students are expected to attend the school on all days and for the full day. Half day applications will not be entertained.
- Students must be present in the school after holidays / vacations on the reopening day of the school. They must also remain present in the school on the last working day of the school, preceding the holidays/vacations.
- All students are expected to report 10 minutes before the scheduled school time.
- A pupil must have 75% of total attendance to be eligible for promotion. Proper and valid medical certificate from competent authority must be produced for absence for more than six continuous working days.
- Continued absence for 15 consecutive working days without prior intimation to the school will result in the student's name being struck off without notice to the parents
- Parent should make a request for leave in advance and only when they are convinced of its absolute necessity or if it is a case of injury or illness of the student.

- Students will not be sent home even in an emergency with anyone who might come to pick them up during school hours without a written request from the parent or guardian. A student shall be permitted to leave the school premises during school hours only if escorted by parents/guardians/teachers or on a special request made by the parent. While leaving the campus, an out pass signed by the Principal and class teacher must be obtained and shown at the gate.
- Any student who is late in attending school should; write the reason in "Late Attendance Record" page in the Students' Diary, obtain the signature of his/her parent/guardian and the same has to be brought to the notice of Class Teacher and Principal before entering to his/her classroom.

Shamray GreyShirt, Navy Blue Tie with White Stripes, Navy Blue Trousers, School Belt, Black Socks & Black Shoes

Wednesday - House Uniform, BlackSocks & BlackShoes.

Grade 6 to 10 (Girls): Monday, Tuesday, Thursday& Friday

Shamray GreyShirt, Navy Blue Blazer, Navy Blue Tie with White Stripes, Navy Blue Trousers, School Belt, Black Socks & Black Shoes.

Wednesday - House Uniform, Black Socks & Black Shoes.

Grade 11 & 12 (Boys & Girls): White Shirt, Navy Blue Blazer(For girls), Navy Blue Tie with White Stripes, Navy Blue Trousers, Black Belt, White Socks & Black Shoes

- Wearing of school uniform is compulsory for the students on all
 working days. No exemption for wearing of uniform will be granted
 on religious grounds. Students who come to the school on holidays
 are also required to wear uniform. Any modification to the school
 uniform is strictly not allowed.
- Correct and tidy school uniform with identity card must be worn. If for any reason a student cannot wear uniform prior permission of the Class Teacher must be obtained with the support of a request made by the parent in the Students' Diary.
- Low waist pants and short shirts are strictly forbidden.
- On their birthday, students are free to wear clothes of their choice that conform to norms of modesty.
- The students are allowed to wear pure black sandals with rear straps if the weather is rainy.
- Hair must be kept neat and tidy at all times. Fancy hair styling, tinting, dyeing, highlighting and bleaching of hair are strictly not allowed for all students.
- Girls, who grow their hair long, should keep it sleek ponytail with Black Hair Band.
- Boys should maintain their hair properly trimmed and neatly combed. Boys must be neat in appearance and clean-shaven at all times.
- Boys are not allowed to wear earrings/ear studs, ear sticks or have any other forms of body piercing.
- Nails must be kept short and clean. Nail polish, varnish or hardener is not allowed.

JEWELLERY & ELECTRONIC GADGETS

- Jewellery and costly ornaments are not to be worn by students. The school takes no responsibility for the safety of such articles. Only small and simple ear rings are permitted for girls. Artificial and decorative ornaments also will not be permitted. Students up to class III are not allowed to wear wrist watches.
- Mobile phones, DVDs, Pen Drives, Tablets, Memory Cards etc. are strictly prohibited in the school. Any electronic gadgets, if found, will be confiscated and will not be returned in any case.

PARENT CO-OPERATION

- Parents are expected to support and reinforce the school rules and policies. The school expects parents to attend parentteacher meetings and school functions.
- Parents must ensure that their children are not sent to the school
 if they are unwell. Children suffering from infectious or
 contagious diseases should not to be sent to school before they
 are fully cured. In such cases a medical fitness certificate must
 be produced on rejoining.
- Parents are expected to pay special attention to the text books and note books of their wards. These must be kept neat and tidy.
 The particulars (Name, class & Division) should be written on all belongings of the pupils of classes Montessori - 1 to Grade 2.
- The school attaches great importance to discipline. The parents
 are expected to fully co-operate with the school authorities in
 enforcing the same. In matters of discipline the decisions of the
 school authorities will be deemed final.

- Parents are welcome to visit the school off and on to discuss the progress of their wards. On such occasions they are required to meet the Principal first. The visit may be made between 2pm and 4.00 pm on working days.
- The school will conduct periodical Face to Face meetings of parents, CLASS WISE. It is compulsory for all parents to attend suchmeetings. Previous permission from the Principal is required to visit a teacher during the school hours other than the scheduled meetings.
- Parents or guardians are specially requested to notify the school of any change in their address or telephone numbers.
- Parents are expected to fully cooperate with the school for preparing the children for various competitions, examinations, performances etc. Parents are also expected to accompany the students for all the competitions, examinations, performances etc. conducted at venues outside the school premises, if selected and recommended by the school.
- School Annual Day Celebrations will be held in every two years.
- Whenever the school takes the students to participate in external activities / competitions, the parents have to bear the expenses.
- Parents are given to understand that they cannot dictate to the Principal and School management. The Management has the sole rights to admit or retain pupils in the school or cancel the admission of the student at its own discretion.
- All parents/students shall accept and adhere to the changes and modifications in the rules & regulation of the school, brought about by the management from time to time.
- All the parents are directed to install the school software in their mobile phones and maintain the same for receiving and sending communications

LIBRARY RULES

- Only one book at a time will be issued on appointed days.
- Library books are issued only to the students of Grades 4 and above. Students of Grades 1 to 3 are provided books to read during their library period and the same has to be returned to the librarian after the library period.
- No pupil may keep the book with him/her for more than 7 days.
- A book may be issued for a further period of 7 days, if there is no demand for it by any other student.
- All library books must be returned before the Annual Examination.
- The Librarian should be notified by the borrower if the book is damaged before accepting the book. Otherwise the borrower will be held responsible and the pupil will have to make good the damage.
- If a student loses a book, the student will have to replace the book or pay double the value of the book as fine.
- Any student who infringes the Library rules will be liable to pay a fine or be debarred from the Library.

SCHOOL PROPERTIES

- Do leave the areas in school in a better condition and state of cleanliness after use.
- Take good care of school properties and premises. If any school property is found to have been damaged / destroyed, the cost of replacement for vandalized items will be borne by student(s) responsible for the damage.
- If the student(s) guilty for damage of school properties cannot be found, the entire class will bear the expenses for the compensation.

SCHOOL VEHICHLE RULES

 School Transport service is an optional service facilitated by the school for the convenience of its students. The school vehicle facility available to the student cannot be expected or demanded as a matter of right.

- Students availing the vehicle facility will be provided with a vehicle number, pick up and alighting stops. Generally the bus timings will operate within 10 to15 minutes of the pickup and alighting time. Parents are requested to accommodate the same.
- Any change in the timings will be notified to the parent by the Transport Department.
- Students will have to board and alight the school vehicle at the respective stops allotted to them. The Transport Dept. reserves the rights to allot the stops.
- Students while travelling on the school vehicle must maintain discipline. Any student guilty of misconduct will not be allowed to avail the bus facility.
- A student shall be refused the vehicle facility if involved in damage to the vehicle property. Besides, the damage done will have to be compensated by the student.
- No transport facility shall be available for other activities / events that school may plan on holidays / vacations.
- Vehicle employees are not authorized to change/add stops.
- During the initial month of the academic year transportation may not be well regulated. All parents are requested to cooperate with the school.
- The school has taken utmost care for the safety and convenience of the students. Any suggestion /complaint regarding the transport service are to be made in writing strictly to the Transport Department of the school and the same shall be entertained by the Transport Department of the school only.
- It is important that any change to the usual pick-up / drop routine is intimated to the class teacher a day in advance.
- Parents and students are expected to cooperate with the vehicle employees.

SCHOOL FEE

- FEE DAYS ARE MENTIONED IN THE SCHOOL CALENDAR AND STUDENT PLANNER.
- After the due date of fee remittance, Rs.100/-will be charged as late fee and on each consecutive days of Late payment Rs10/- will be charged additionally.
- Parents are requested to keep a track of fee payment days to ensure timely payment of school – fee so as to avoid payment of late fee.
- Parents who pay the fee using UPI, should send its screen shot to office mobile number once the payment is done.
- Failure to pay the fee by the specified date will result in the removal of the pupil's name from the rolls of the school. Readmission will be considered only on payment of the Re admission fee along with the fee dues.
- School fee statement will only be issued for the present academic year. Parents who file tax returns are requested to collect the same each year if necessary. Please note that request for fee statement should reach the office before 7 working days.
- SCHOOL FEE WILL BE REVISED EVERY YEAR BY THE MANAGEMENT TO MEET THE INCREASE IN EXPENDITURE.
- If the Child takes **TC** in between an academic year, full fee for the academic year must be paid.

WITHDRAWAL

- Advance notice is to be given before the withdrawal of a student.
 The person responsible should give such notice in writing for the student and not by the pupil. However the fee once paid, including the admission fee will not be refunded nor transferred under any circumstances.
- Pupils who leave without notice and pupils whose names are stuck off the rolls for unexplained absence of more than one month are as a rule, not re-admitted.
- Parents are requested to notify the office on time when the student leaves the school and also the fees will have to be paid

for year...

- Transfer Certificate should be applied for in writing by the parent or guardian in the prescribed form along with No Due Certificates from the Accounts Department and Library. One week notice must be given for the issue of Transfer Certificate.
- Caution deposit will only be refunded within three months from the issue of TC.All refund claims must be made in person by producing the original receipt.

INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

- All students at all times will behave well and sensibly and show courtesy, consideration and respect for others and do nothing that will bring the school's name into disrepute.
- All school rules apply to all students from the time they leave home for school until they have returned home at the end of the school day, or while taking part in any activity organized by, or related to the school.
- Although the school is not responsible for the behavior of its students outside its premises, due notice will be taken of reports of misbehavior and disciplinary action will be taken against them if the report is substantiated on proper enquiry.
- Pupils must always be neat and presentable (Hair Cut, Nails, Shoes etc. should be neat and clean).
- Pupils are expected to come to school provided with all that is necessary for their day's work. Borrowing or lending of pencils, erasers, rulers, instrument box, etc. is discouraged.
- Take care of all your belongings. It is not advisable for the pupils to bring money or valuable articles unnecessarily to school.
- During the absence of the teacher, each Class Monitor is responsible for the order and discipline of the class.
- Pupils from one class may not visit their friends in any other class during their recess.

- AS ENGLISH IS THE MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION IN THE SCHOOL, STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO SPEAK ONLY IN ENGLISH. (IN THE SCHOOL PREMISES, SCHOOL VEHICLE AND EVEN DURING ANY SCHOOL FUNCTIONS CONDUCTED OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL PREMISES.)
- Corridor is a place to walk silently, running and loud talking are strictly prohibited. Running, playing or shouting inside the school building is not advisable.
- If the whole class moves through the corridor, follow queue system compulsorily.
- If a student wishes to move out of the classroom other than during the scheduled breaks, he/she must obtain an out pass from the teacher in charge for that particular period.
- School dining area should be utilized properly. You should maintain discipline near the canteen by falling in a queue and avoid loud noise.
- Silence and order must be maintained in the library.
- Wastage of food should be avoided.
- Take responsibility of the cleanliness of your class room and surroundings.
- Never throw waste anywhere than in the waste basket.
- If you are undergoing any regular medication the same should be intimated to your class teacher.
